



Frequently Asked Questions

Registration

How do I register for the Summit?

Register on the <u>Zoom Events page</u>. Zoom only accepts credit card payments. If you would like to
pay via check or invoice, please complete this <u>Alternative Payment form</u>. We will contact you to
complete registration.

Do I need a Zoom account to register?

• Yes. Zoom Events requires all registrants to have a Zoom account. If you do not have one, you can sign up for a free account here.

What if I need to pay by check?

• If you would like to pay via check or invoice, please complete this <u>Alternative Payment form</u>. We will contact you to complete registration.

How do I register for another person?

- If you are registering for someone else and would like to pay by credit card, you can register via
 Zoom Events. Please note: You must enter the registrant's Zoom account information in order
 to complete registration. Do not register someone else under your account, otherwise the
 participant will not be able to access the event. Make sure you get their login information
 before completing registration.
- Zoom only allows you to complete one registration at a time. Please see information below about registering multiple people.

How do I register multiple people?

• If you would like to register multiple people and pay via invoice (as opposed to paying with a credit card), please complete this <u>Alternative Payment form</u>. We will contact you to complete registration.
