


THE POTENTIAL

Streets and sidewalks are our backyards, and can be the places where: neighbors meet, children play, commerce occurs, and people-watching happens.









SCHOOL STREETS

When school is in session, nearby New York City streets have significantly higher rates of crashes and injuries.

<u>And the streets in predominantly non-</u> <u>white districts are 43% more dangerous</u> <u>than primarily white schools.</u>

Every day, we send our youngest New Yorkers to school using streets and sidewalks that are uniquely dangerous and inadequately protected.
